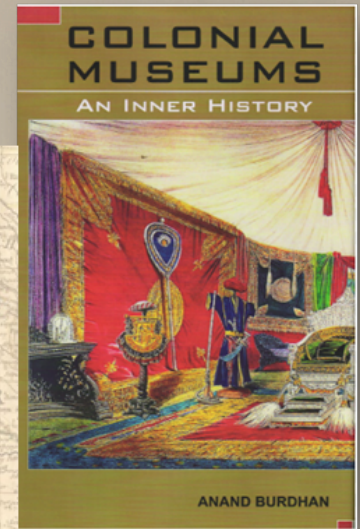
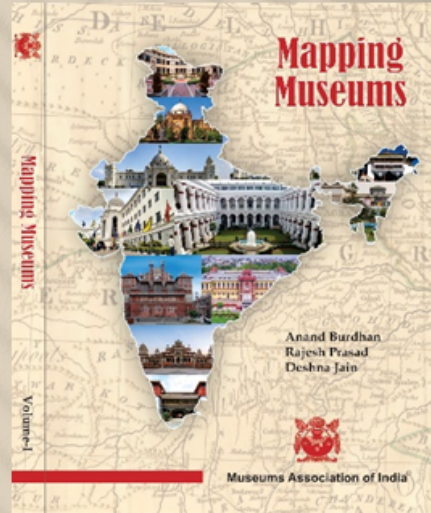
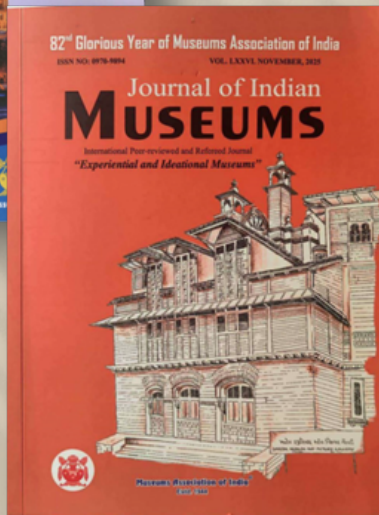
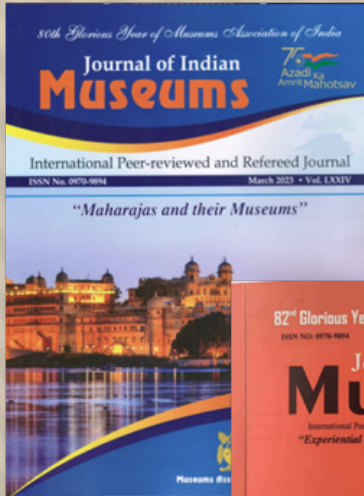
- To serve the museum fraternity and cultural communities with ingenious research, adequate training and scientific spirit.
